## EXEMPTION

I, Galeva Kwarara, Minister for National Planning and Development, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 7 of the *National Investment and Development Act 1974* and all other powers me enabling, having received a report from NIDA and being of the opinion that the purposes, structure, control or operation of Ramu Sugar Holdings Limited ("RSHL") and Ramu Sugar Limited ("RSL") is such that it is not necessary that RSHL or RSL should be treated for the purposes of the Act as foreign enterprises, hereby exempt RSHL and RSL from the operations of Part VI and Part VIII of the Act, subject to the conditions specified in the Schedule.

## SCHEDULE

1. RSHL and RSL shall establish and implement the Ramu Sugar Project as described in the Master Agreement dated 24th August, 1979 entered into between the Independent State of Papua New Guinea and RSHL ("Project").
2. This exemption relates to the Project and shall remain in effect whilst the Project continues to operate.
3. The RSHL and RSL shall be entitled to the investment guarantees provided in Part IV of the Act.
