*Forestry (Private Dealings) Act (Chapter 217)***DECLARATION OF LOCAL FOREST AREA**

I, Paia Wingti, Prime Minister and Minister for Forests, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 4(1) of the *Forestry (Private Dealings) Act (Chapter 217)* and all other powers me enabling, and being satisfied that:—

(a) it is proper to do so having regard to—

- (i) the interests of the owners by custom of the timber in any land (including their interests in having their land cleared and so enabling agricultural development to take place on the land); and
- (ii) the national interests; and
- (iii) the prospects for the economic exploitation of the timber; and

(b) the area is one suitable for exploitation under the Act,

hereby declare the area of land specified in the Schedule to be a Local Forest Area for the purposes of the Act.

**SCHEDULE**

An area known as Napantah-Nubui Local Forest Area of approximately 12 000 hectares situated in the Milinches of Karu south-east Ulaputur north-east and Dolomakas north-west in the Namatanai Sub-district of the New Ireland Province commencing at the high water mark of Dolomakas Bay the same point being the northern most corner of Portion 197 proceeding thence by the western and southern boundaries of the said Portion 197 and Portion 826 generally south-westerly south-easterly and easterly for an approximate total distance of 6 200 metres to the left bank of Nubui River thence by the said bank upstream generally southerly for approximately 2 600 metres thence by an unsurveyed line bearing approximately 320 degrees for 25 000 metres to the Namatanai-Ulaputur Road thence by the Road and the boundary of Portion 391 and Portion 431 generally easterly for an approximate total distance of 11 500 metres to the western boundaries of Namatanai Township thence southerly easterly and generally northerly by the boundaries of the said Namatanai Township for a total distance of approximately 4 400 meters to the right outlet bank of Matakan River and the high water mark of Nabuto Bay thence by the said high water mark of Nabuto Bay and the high water mark of South Pacific Ocean and the boundaries of numerous Portions along the coast the boundary proceeds generally north-easterly south-easterly south-westerly and south-easterly for a total distance of approximately 55 400 metres to the point of commencement and be the several said dimensions a little more or a little less and excluding Portion 39, Portion 146, Portion 154, Portions 828 and 829, Portion 832, Portions 840C and 841C, Portions 4, 5 and Portions 846 to 848 inclusive and all the said Portions being either State Lands or Freehold Lands.

## NOTIFICATION OF REGISTRATION OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS

I, hereby notify that the engineers specified in the Schedule hereto are Registered Engineers as defined under the Act. Registered Engineers are entitled to practise as professional engineers in accordance with Part V of the Act and to use the identifying title "Reg Eng." after their name. A person, Company, Statutory Body, Government Body or Organisation who employs an unregistered person as a professional engineer is guilty of an offence. An unregistered person who practises as a professional engineer is guilty of an offence. Applications for exemption from registration and the provisions of the Act may be made to the Board under Section 17 of the Act.

Employers of professional engineers should note:

- (1) a list, which shall cancel all previous lists, of persons currently registered under the Act shall appear annually in the *National Gazette* during the month of March; and
- (2) an addendum to the annual list, of persons subsequently registered, or deregistered, shall appear quarterly during the months of June, September and December.
- (3) Certificates issued annually or quarterly to persons registered under this Act, must be displayed in a prominent position in the office given as the place of practice.

This notice is published in accordance with Section 12 of the Act.

*Land Act (Chapter 185)*  
LAND AVAILABLE FOR LEASING

**A. APPLICANT:**

Applicants or Tenderers should note—

1. Full name (block letters), occupation and address;
2. If a Company, the proper Registered Company name and address of the Company representative;
3. If more than one person, the tenancy desired and, if tenancy in common, the division of shares.

Applicants or tenderers should note—

4. That a lease cannot be held in a name registered under the Business Names Act only; and
5. That in the case of death in joint tenancy, the deceased partner's interest vests in the surviving partner and, in the case of tenancy in common, the deceased partner's interest vests in his estate.

**B. TYPE OF LEASE:**

Leases provided for are Business, Residence, Pastoral, Agricultural, Mission, Special Purposes and Town Subdivision Leases. With the exception of Town Subdivision Leases, State Leases may be granted for a maximum period of 99 years. Town Subdivision Leases have a maximum duration of 5 years.

Applicants should note that, in the case of town land the purpose of the lease must be in accordance with the zoning as declared under the *Town Planning Act*.

**C. PROPOSED PURPOSES, IMPROVEMENTS, ETC:**

The applicant or tenderer should provide fullest details (on attachment if necessary) of his proposal for the lease including information on—

1. Financial status or prospects;
2. Details of other land holdings in Papua New Guinea including approximate value of improvements to these holdings;
3. Approximate value and type of proposed improvements to the land applied for;
4. Experience and abilities to develop the land;
5. Any other details which would support the application.

**D. DESCRIPTION OF LAND:**

To be used only in NOT in response to an advertisement. A brief description giving area and locality is required. A sketch plan should be provided on an attachment. Where possible the land parcel should be identified on a map published by the Lands Department.

In the case of Tenders or an advertisement of land available for leasing the description is to be inserted in the column provided under the heading "Tender or Land Available Preference".

**E. TENDER OF LAND AVAILABLE PREFERENCE:**

The preference should be clearly indicated. In cases where there are more than 20 preferences the additional preferences may be shown on attachment. The "Description" should give the Lot and Section number or the Portion number as shown in the *Gazette*. The "Amount Offered" column need only be completed in the case of tenders.

**F. TENDERERS:**

Tenderers should take particular note that a tender for an amount less than the reserve price (being 60% of the unimproved value of the land) is invalid and shall not be considered. The successful tenderer will be required to pay the full amount of the tender.

**G. TOWN SUBDIVISION LEASES:**

In addition to the requirements of the relevant sections above, an applicant or tenderer for a Town Subdivision Lease shall submit:

- (i) A preliminary proposal for the subdivision
- (ii) A preliminary sketch plan of the proposed subdivision
- (iii) Provisional proposals for subdivision surveys and installation of roads and drainage.

**H. FEES:**

2. Following the grant of the lease, an additional fee of K50 (preparation of lease fee), and if surveyed, the survey fee as prescribed and, in the case of tender, the amount of the tender shall be payable within two months from the date of grant, i.e. from the date of gazettal of the recommended lease holder in the *PNG National Gazette*.

3. If not surveyed, the payment of survey fee may be deferred until survey.

**NOTE:** If more than one block is required an additional Application Fee for each additional block must be paid.
