Public Holidays Act (Chapter 321)

APPOINTMENT OF PUBLIC HOLIDAYS

I, IGNATIUS KILAGE, G.C.M.G., C.B.E., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the *Public Holidays Act* (Chapter 321) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby—

- (a) revoke the appointment of 13th August, 1989 as a public holiday throughout East New Britain Province; and
- (b) appoint each day specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to be a public holiday throughout the province specified in Column 2 and set out opposite the date in Column 1.
