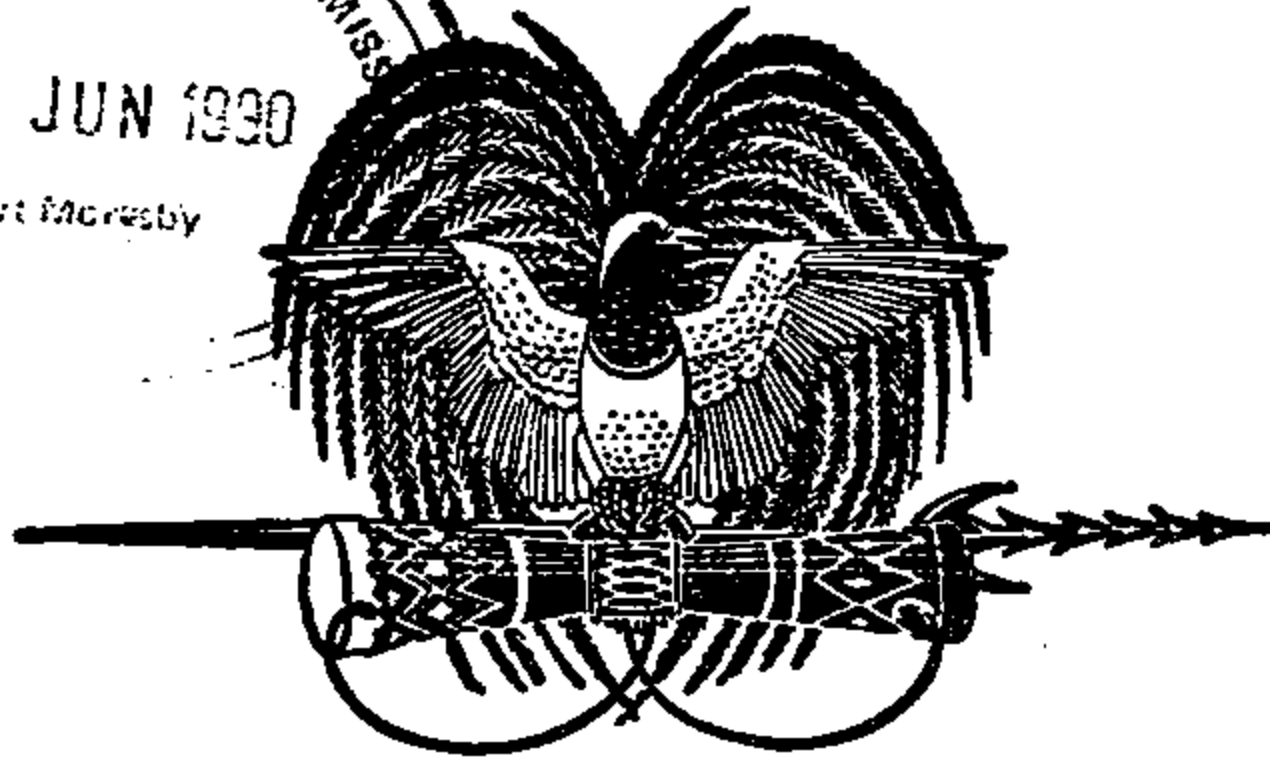

CONSTITUTION**DETERMINATION OF TEMPORARY RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTER**

*National Investment and Development Act (Chapter 120)***EXEMPTION**

I, John Giheno, Minister for Trade and Industry, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 7 of the *National Investment and Development Act* (Chapter 120) and all other powers me enabling, having received a report from NIDA and being of the reasons given below exempt Loraine Contractors Pte. Ltd. on the grounds that:

1. The Morobe Sports Complex officially known as the Sir Ignatius Kilage Sports Complex is a Government Project for which there is a general exemption under Part 8 of the NIDA Act.
2. The expertise which Loraine will bring into PNG cannot be readily found domestically from local sources.

If the Enterprise wishes to carry on any business or activity in Papua New Guinea other than that specified in Schedule 2, the Enterprise must apply for registration in regard to that business in accordance with Part VI of the Act.
