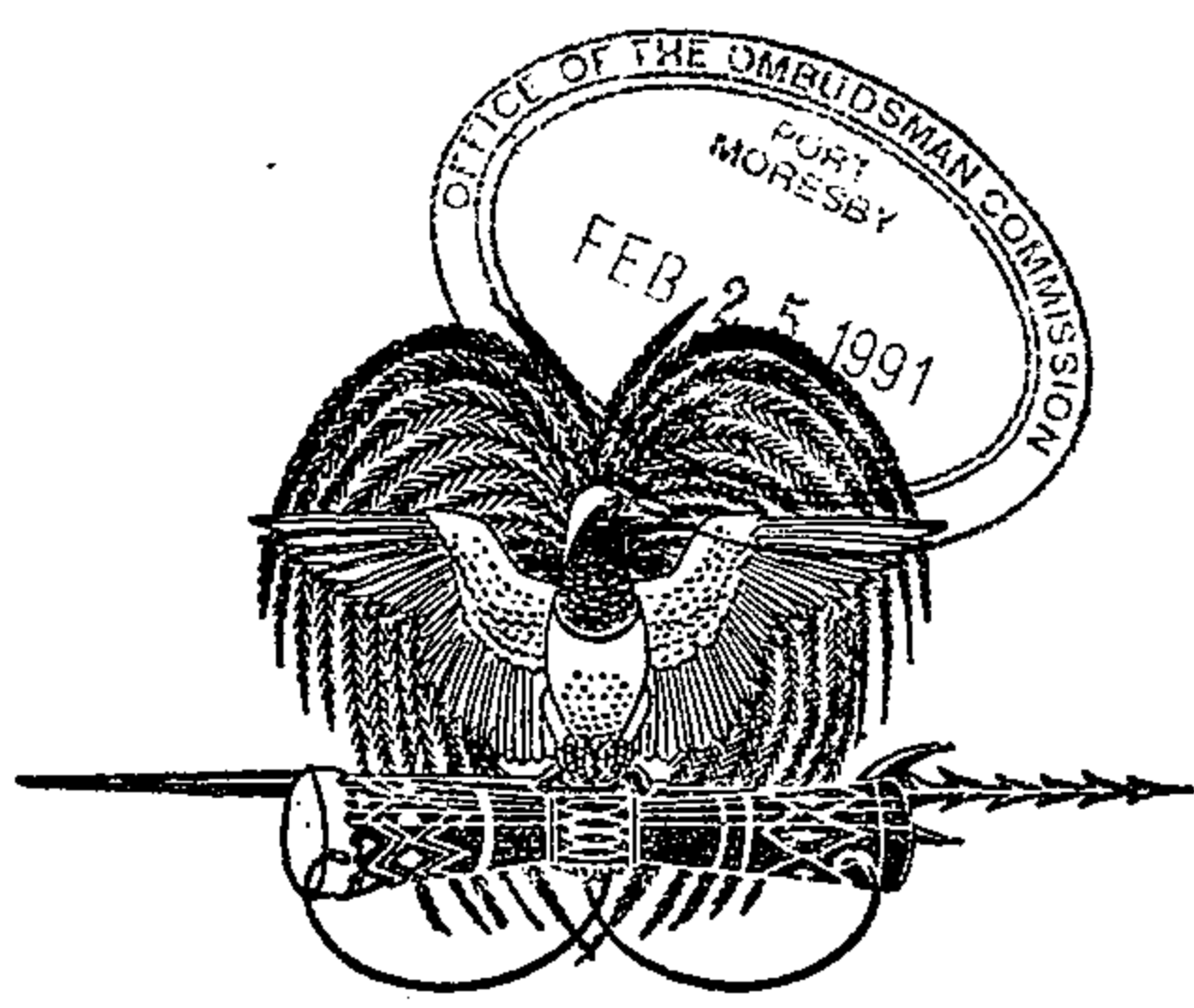

Public Holidays Act (Chapter 321)

APPOINTMENT OF PUBLIC HOLIDAY
