PUBLIC NOTICE

I, Wiwa Korowi, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 1, 2 and 3 of the *Public Holidays Act (Chapter 321)* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby—

- (a) appoint Monday 13th June, 1994 to be the day to commemorate the birthday of the Queen; and
- (b) appoint Friday 16th September, 1994 to be the day to commemorate the attainment of Independent Sovereign Nationhood; and
- (c) for general information notify that the following days shall be observed as Public Holidays throughout Papua New Guinea:—
