## NATIONAL CAPITAL DISTRICT COMMISSION

A LAWEntitled**NATIONAL CAPITAL DISTRICT (SALES AND SERVICE TAX) (AMENDMENT) LAW, 1998**

Being

A law made pursuant to the *National Capital District Commission Act 1990* as amended and the *National Capital Commission (Sale and Service Tax) Regulation 1991* to amend the *National Capital District Commission Sales and Service Tax Law 1995*, and to provide for the imposition of taxes on the sale of goods and the provisions of services in the National Capital District and for related purposes.

MADE by the National Capital District Commission to come into operation on the 1st of January, 1999.

**1. REPEAL AND REPLACEMENT OF SECTION 8**

Section 8 of the National Capital District Sales and Services Tax Law, 1995 is repealed and is replaced with the following:—

"8. Rates:—

- (1) Subject to sub-section 3, sales tax shall be charged at the rate of 4% on the sale value of all goods sold in the National Capital District.
- (2) Subject to sub-section 3, services tax shall be charged at the rate of 4% on the value of all services supplied, provided or rendered in the National Capital District.
- (3) In respect to the purchase of Domestic airline tickets for travel out of National Capital District the tax shall be charged at a fixed rate of K4.00."

## CERTIFICATE
