### CALL-OUT OF THE PAPUA NEW GUINEA DEFENCE FORCE

I, Sir Michael Ogio, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 20 of the Defence Act (Chapter 74) and Section 204 of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby call-out the Papua New Guinea Defence Force to be deployed as and when required by the Commissioner of Police to parts or areas of the Country as determined by the Commissioner of Police to assist Police, restore law and order for a period up to and one month after the date of the return of the writs of the 2012 general elections, commencing on and from the date of signature of this instrument.
