ALTERATION TO THE CONSTITUTION

The Government proposes to alter the constitution pursuant to the requirement of Section 14(2) (*making of alterations to the Constitution*) of the Constitution, I, Theodore Zurenuoc Speaker of the National Parliament, hereby publish the proposed Law.

Constitutional Amendment (Motions of No Confidence) Law 2012,

ARRANGEMENT OF CLAUSE.

Motions of no confidence (Amendment of Section 145).

THE CONSTITUTION

Being a Law to alter the Constitution to increase the period for vote of no confidence to thirty months,

MADE by the National Parliament.

Section 145(4) of the Constitution is amended by repealing the words "eighteen months" and substituting them with the words "thirty months".
