*Broadcasting Corporation Act (Chapter 149)*

### **REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN, DEPUTY CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL BROADCASTING CORPORATION BOARD**

I, Grand Chief Sir Michael Ogio, GCL., G.C.M.G., K. St. J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 193(2) of the Constitution and Sections 12 and 16 of the *Broadcasting Corporation Act* (Chapter 149) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consultation with the Public Services Commission and the Permanent Parliamentary Committee on appointments, hereby—

(a) revoke the appointment of:—

- (ii) Kain Wosae as Chairman and Paul Reptario as Deputy Chairman of the National Broadcasting Corporation Board, for a period of three (3) years,
