## CORRIGENDUM

PURSUANT to Section 73(1) of the *Oil and Gas Act*, a notice under the heading Application for Grant of a Gas Condensate Pipeline Licence (APL 9), which appeared in the *National Gazette* No. G227 on 14th June, 2012 on page 6 is to be amended to read:

It is notified that Eaglewood Energy (BVI) Limited of P.O. Box 919, Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea, has amended its' application for the Grant of a Gas Condensate Strategic Pipeline Licence extending from the Ubuntu Central Processing Facility (CPF) to the Drimdensuk Export Facility on the Fly River in the Western Province.

The application covers a 20 metre wide corridor, buried separated gas and liquid pipeline, a length of approximately 75 kilometre pipeline from the Ubuntu Central Processing Facility (CPF) to the Drimdensuk Export Facility.

Furthermore, pursuant to Section 73(9) of the *Oil and Gas Act*, potential third party users of the pipeline are hereby invited to make submissions to the Minister within a period of fourteen (14) days from the date of publication of this Notice in the *National Gazette*, as to their potential requirements in using the pipeline and the contents of the access arrangements to apply to the pipeline.

As required by Section 73(10) of the *Oil and Gas Act*, the submitted draft access arrangements, are available for inspection at the Office of the Director.

It is notified that Eaglewood Energy (BVI) Limited of P.O. Box 919, Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea, has amended its' application for the Grant of a Strategic Petroleum Processing Facility Licence adjacent to the Ubuntu Gas Condensate Discovery in the Western Province.

1. The application proposes to construct, commission and operate facilities and services to separate condensate and process gas for reinjection or further processing;
2. Such ancillary facilities as are reasonably required by the Applicant for the safe and efficient operation of the facilities.
