## EASTABLISHMENT OF THE PACIFIC GAMES (2015) SPECIAL SUPPLY AND TENDERS BOARD

I, James Marape, MP., Minister for Finance, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 39A of the *Public Finances (Management) Act 1995*, and acting on the advice of the Departmental Head of the Department responsible for financial management, and all other powers me enabling, hereby establish the Pacific Games (2015) Authority Special Supply and Tenders Board, comprising of —

- (a) Pacific Games Authority (2015) Chairman; and
- (b) Minister or his nominee from PNG Sports Foundation; and
- (c) General Secretary of PNGPGA; and
- (d) Treasurer of PNGPGA; and
- (e) Co-opted Member; and
- (f) the Secretary for Finance or his nominee, ex-officio; and
- (g) the Secretary for Treasury or his nominee, ex-officio,

with effect on and from the date of publication of his instrument in the *National Gazette* until 31st July, 2015, on which date this Board shall cease to exist.

Pacific Games (2015) Special Supply and Tenders Board Rules 2013.

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A Rule

MADE by the Minister pursuant to Section 39A(2) of the *Public Finances (Management) Act 1995*, prescribing the conduct of the Pacific Games (2015) Special Supply and Tenders Board to come into operation in accordance with a notice in the *National Gazette* and to cease operation on 31st July, 2015.

1. APPLICATION.

This Rule only applies to the tender for purchase and disposal of goods, works and services for the 2015 Pacific Games.

2. MEETINGS OF THE BOARD.

- (1) The quorum for a meeting of the Board shall be four (4).
- (2) A member of the Board who has an interest in any of the matters for consideration by the Board shall disclose that interest and disqualify himself or herself from the meeting.

3. TENDERS.

- (1) The Board shall meet as and when necessary to invite tenders for the purchase or disposal of goods, works or services up to the value of K1,000,000.00.
- (2) The procurement of goods, works or services by the Board above the value of K500,000.00 shall apply for an Authority to Pre-Commit.
- (3) Tenders shall be considered on a competitive market basis and the three (3) bids representing value for money shall be short-listed for the Board to then make a decision.
- (4) All tenders shall be advertised in the print media.

4. CONSULTANTS.

The Board shall engage the services of technical consultants to provide technical evaluation advice in respect of the procurement or disposal of goods, works or services for the 2015 Pacific Games.
