PROTOCOL ON SUBSTANCES THAT DEplete THE OZONE LAYER**

(b) authorize the Minister for Foreign Affairs and Immigration to sign the Instrument of Accession, thus effecting the application of the provisions of the Montreal Amendment (1997) and the Beijing Amendment (1999) to the Montreal Protocol on substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer.

- (b) authorize the Minister for Foreign Affairs and Immigration to sign the Treaty thus effecting the application of the provisions of the International Convention on Harmonized Commodity Description and Coding System (Harmonized System Convention).
