AMENDMENT OF DETERMINATION OF TITLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTERS

I, Peter O'Neill, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 148 of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, hereby amend the Determination of Titles and Responsibilities of Ministers published in the *National Gazette* No. G304 dated 10th August, 2012 —

- (a) in Schedule 12 (Minister for Higher Education, Research, Science and Technology) —
 - (i) in Column 3, by repealing “(1) Institute of Medical Research”; and
 - (ii) in Column 4, by repealing “*Institute of Medical Research Act* (Chapter 166) (excepts S.24(2) and (5))”; and

- (b) in Schedule 23 (Minister for Health and HIV AIDS) —
- (i) in Column 3, by inserting “Institute of Medical Research”; and
 - (ii) in Column 4, by inserting “*Institute of Medical and Research Act* (Chapter 166) (Except S.24(2) and (5))”.;and
- (c) in Schedule 32 (Minister for National Planning), Column 3 —
- (i) by repealing “(f) Office of Rural Development.”; and
 - (ii) by deleting “;and” in Paragraph (e) and substituting”.”.
