DECLARATION OF PORT OF ENTRY-BORDER POST OF KEKERE (SEROVAI) IN KEITA DISTRICT CENTRAL BOUGAINVILLE

I, **Ray Paul Chief Commissioner of Customs**, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by Section 8(b) of the *Customs Act* (Chapter 101 as amended) and all the other powers enabling me, for the purpose of the *Customs Act* and its related legislation, hereby appoint the place described in Schedule 1 of this instrument and more specifically shown on the sketch annexed hereto, as a place for the examination of passengers and goods on arrival.

SCHEDULE 1

All that piece or parcel of land and Port structure situated within the Kekere (Serovai) Keita District of Central Bougainville in Autonomous Region of Bougainville be the Port of Kekere (Serovai) commencing at Point KCUS 1, Degrees 06, Minutes 24, Seconds 33.05 Latitude/Longitude S, Degrees 155, Minutes 50, Seconds 04.05 Latitude/Longitude E. Point KSCUS 2, Degrees 06, Minutes 24 Seconds 24.00, Latitude/Longitude S, Degrees 155, Minutes 50, Seconds 08.07, Latitude/Longitude E. Point KCUS 3, Degrees 06, Minutes 24, Seconds 23.07, Latitude/Longitude S, Degrees 155, Minutes 50, Seconds 03.04, Latitude/Longitude E. Point KCUS 4, Degrees 06, Minutes 24, Seconds 32.01, Latitude/Longitude S, Degrees 155, Minutes 49, Seconds 53.09, Latitude/Longitude E.

The appointment of Sirowai as described in Schedule 1 of this instrument as a place for the examination of goods on landing has effect from 5th August, 2019 and may be revoked by a subsequent Notice.
