## DECLARATION OF WHARF-LAE PORT TIDAL BASIN, MOROBE PROVINCE

I, Ray Paul, Chief Commissioner of Customs, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by section 7(1)(c) of the Customs Act (Chapter 101 as amended) and all the other powers enabling me, for the purpose of the Customs Act and its related legislation, hereby appoint the place described in schedule 1 of this instrument and more specifically shown on the sketch annexed hereto, as a limited Port for the propose port operations.

### SCHEDULE 1

All that piece or parcel of land and wharf structure situated within the city of Lae Milinch of Lae Fourmile of Markham in the Morobe Province be the port of Lae Tidal Basin commencing at point 1 on the eastly extremity adjoining to Bumbu Road Port at position altitude 6 44'9.15" and longitude 146 58'49.64"E than to Port 2 altitude 6 44'10.16"S and longitude 146 58'46.48"E than to Point 3 altitude 6 44'10.71"S and longitude 146 58'46.48"E than to Point 4 latitude 6 44'10.71"S and longitude 146 58'44.39"S than to Point 5 latitude 6 44'7.65"E than to Point 6 corner of wharf structure at the southern end latitude 6 44'5.80"S and longitude 146 58'44.10"E and then to Point 7 latitude 6 44'6.32"S and longitude 146 58'42.40"E than to Point 8 at straight line of quay face at altitude 6 43'58.89"S and longitude 146 58'39.99"E and then to Point 9 at the rear structure on the northern end of the berth wharf latitude 6 43'58.31"S and longitude 164 58'41.97"E than to Point 10 at latitude 6 43'55.47"S and longitude 146 58'40.87"E and to Point 11 latitude 6 43'52.64"S and longitude of 146 58'49.54"E than turn and closes at Point 1 starting point.

### SCHEDULE 2

The wharf located within the area known as Lae Tidal Basin and being part of the Port of Lae will be exclusively used by the public and private sector for the import and export of general sea freight cargo destined for commercial and non-commercial purposes.

The port operators South Pacific International Container Terminal Ltd (Lessee), will facilitate the storage, recording and movement of cargoes within the Lae Tidal Basin wharf from PNG Ports Limited (Lessor).

The appointment of this wharf has effect from 5th of February, 2019 and may be revoked by a subsequent notice.
