CERTIFICATION OF CAPACITY

2025 LOCAL LEVEL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS SPECIAL PROCUREMENT COMMITTEE

The Authority to Pre-Commit Committee (APCC), under Section 28 of the amended *National Procurement Act 2021*, hereby certifies and endorses the committee members for the 2025 Local Level Government Elections Special Procurement Committee of the National Procurement Board to procure internally up to the threshold limit of K5 million with the following;

1. The 2025 Local Level Government Elections Special Procurement Committee is valid only for the period of the 2025 Local Level Government Elections commencing on the date affixed on this certificate and shall expire on 31st December, 2025.
2. This Special Procurement Committee will only procure the 2025 Local Level Government Elections related goods and services.
3. The purpose of the Committee is to:
 - . Undertake, manage, control and regulate procurements within its threshold level of K5 million.
 - . Safeguard public funds and promote adherence to sound public financial management practices.
 - . Ensure fairness amongst suppliers and transparency when procuring goods, services and works, and;
 - . Ensure procurement is conducted in a timely manner.
