INSTRUMENT OF DELEGATION SECTION 32 AND 33 POWERS FOR EXPENDITURE UNDER THE GOVERNMENT OF PNG CORPORATE CARD PROGRAM

I, HON. THOMAS OPA, MP., Minister for Finance, by virtue of the powers conferred on me by *Public Finance (Management) Act, 1995* (as amended) and all other powers enabling me hereby:-

1. In accordance with Section 2B of the *Public Finance (Management) Act 1995* delegate limited and conditional Section 32 and 33 powers to the positions of Minister assigned a Portfolio under the Determination of Titles and Responsibilities of Government *National Gazette* notice (as published from time to time).
2. A departmental head under Section 2B is vested with these powers to delegate a power, role or responsibility to any person of their agency assigned a Government of PNG Corporate or Purchase Card:
3. This delegation covers expenditure made only with a Government Corporate Card under the Government of PNG Corporate Card program:
 - (1) The per-transaction limit is up to K5,000.00 or any lower limit stated in the card application approved by the Finance department head.
 - (2) The monthly aggregate limit is up to K50,000 or any lower limit stated in the card application approved by the Finance department head.
 - (3) Cardholders may spend only on official purposes within the approved budget.
 - (4) Cardholders must follow Finance Instruction No. 07 of 2025 on Government of PNG Corporate debit cards and purchasing cards.
 - (5) All Minister corporate card acquittals are to be published on the Department of Finance website within 30 days of their completion.

- (6) The S32 and S33 delegation powers take effect on the date the Finance department head approves the card application.
- (7) The delegation ends when the card is surrendered, cancelled, or suspended or when the Portfolio Minister is no longer the Portfolio Minister under the Determination of Titles and Responsibilities of Government *National Gazette* notice (as published from time to time).
- (8) The Finance department head by recommendation from the Department of Finance Corporate Card Unit may suspend the delegation for any breach.
