## **CHAPTER 62**

## **REGISTRATION OF ALIENS**

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGISTRATION OF ALIENS

1. This Act may be cited as the Registration of Aliens Act.

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires — "alien" means a person of the age of eighteen years who is

not a citizen under the provisions of Chapter III of the Constitution:

"registration officer" means an officer of police of a rank not lower than that of Inspector.

3.—(1) Every alien in Solomon Islands shall within twentyeight days of the coming into force of this Act make application for registration in the Form A in the Schedule hereto.

Aliens in Solomon Islands to apply for registration LN 88 of 1978 Schedule

- (2) Every such application shall be in writing in duplicate, and shall be made by delivering the same personally to the officer in charge of a police station who shall issue a receipt to the applicant as in Form B in the Schedule hereto.
- (3) Every such application shall be signed by the applicant in person with his usual signature, unless he is unable to write, in which case he shall, in the presence of the police officer to whom application is made, affix to the application such thumb print or finger prints or other means of identification as the police officer may require.
- **4.**—(1) Every alien who arrives in Solomon Islands after the coming into force of this Act shall make application for registration in the manner set out in section 3 within twenty-eight days of the date of his arrival.

Application by aliens arriving in Solomon Islands LN 88 of 1978

- (2) Every person who after the coming into force of this Act becomes an alien as herein defined whether by attaining the age of eighteen years or otherwise howsoever shall within twentyeight days make application for registration in the manner set out in section 3.
- 5. The police officer to whom the application is made shall, upon receipt thereof, forward the same to a registration officer appointed for the police district in which the applicant resides.

Application to be forwarded to registration officer

Issue of certificate of registration LN 46A of 1978 Schedule 6. The registration officer shall file the application in his office and issue a certificate of registration in the Form C in the Schedule hereto, one copy of which shall be retained at his office, one copy forwarded to the Commissioner of Police with the duplicate of the application, and one copy delivered to the alien on his application at the police station where his application for registration was delivered.

Notice to be given of change of abode or departure LN 88 of 1978

- 7.—(1) Every alien who after receipt of his certificate of registration shall change his place of abode shall within fourteen days of such change notify the officer in charge of the police station nearest to his new place of abode.
- (2) Every alien who after receipt of his certificate of registration is about to leave Solomon Islands shall notify the officer in charge of the police station nearest to his place of abode of his intention to leave Solomon Islands.

Register of aliens LN 46A of 1978 LN 88 of 1978

8. The Commissioner of Police shall cause to be compiled a register of the names, places of abode, and such other particulars as he may deem it expedient to include, of all registered aliens, to be called the Register of Aliens, which shall be amended from time to time by correcting errors therein, by adding thereto the names of aliens to whom certificates of registration have been issued, and by removing therefrom the names of aliens who die, or who leave Solomon Islands, or who otherwise cease to be subject to the provisions of this Act.

Certified copies of entries in Register LN 46A of 1978

- 9.—(1) The Register of Aliens shall not be open as of right to inspection by any person.
- (2) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection (1) the Court may in any proceedings for an offence under this Act order or permit a certified copy of any entry in the Register to be produced in Court.
- (3) Any certificate of registration issued under the provisions of this Act shall be prima facie evidence of the registration of the person to whom such certificate relates.
- (4) A copy certified by the Commissioner of Police or by a police officer acting on his behalf of any entry in the Register shall be prima facie evidence of such entry.
- (5) A certificate under the hand of the Commissioner of Police or of a police officer acting on his behalf, of the absence of any entry in the Register shall be prima facie evidence of the facts stated in such certificate.

- (6) The absence of an entry in the Register relating to any person shall be prima facie evidence that no application for registration has been made by that person.
- (7) Judicial notice shall be taken of the signature of the Commissioner of Police or of a police officer acting on his behalf to any certificate or certified copy referred to in this Act and the signature of a registration officer to any certificate of registration.
- 10. Any person who fails to comply with the provisions of section 3, section 4 or section 7 or who in any application for registration wilfully makes any false statement shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine of one hundred dollars or to imprisonment for six months or to both such fine and imprisonment.
- 11. The Minister may direct that any person or class of persons shall be exempt either unconditionally or subject to such conditions as the Minister may impose from all or any of the provisions of this Act.
