AN ACT to appropriate sixteen million three hundred and seventy three thousand nine hundred and sixty dollars to the service of the year ending the 31st December 1986.

ENACTED by the National Parliament of Solomon Islands.

- Short Title. 1. This Act may be cited as the 1986 Supplementary Appropriation Act 1986.
- Authorisation of issue from the Consolidated Fund of \$16,373,960 to the service of 1986. 2. The issue from the Consolidated Fund is hereby authorised of a sum of sixteen million three hundred and seventy three thousand nine hundred sixty dollars to be applied to the service of the year ending 31st December 1986.
- Appropriation. 3. The sum specified in the preceding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the heads specified, and in the amounts respectively specified in relation thereto, in the First Schedule.
- Development Loans. 4. The Government may, in addition to its borrowings under the provisions of section 4, borrow or enter into agreements to borrow on such terms and conditions as it may determine amounts up to such sums of money for such purposes and from such sources as are respectively specified in the first, second and third columns of the Second Schedule.
