FISHERIES ACT 1972

(No. 13 of 1972)

THE FISHERIES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1995

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 20 of the Fisheries Act, 1972, I, EDMUND ANDRESEN, Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, do hereby make the following Regulations -

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fisheries (Amendment) Regulations 1995.
2. The Second Schedule to the Fisheries Regulations 1972* is hereby deleted and the following new Second Schedule substituted therefor -

Fishing Processing Establishment -

For shore-based processing including
canning, or smoking or cold storage of
tuna and tuna products SI\$10,000.00

For cold storage and processing (filleting and packing) of reef fish and cray fish including button blanks and the aquarium trade	SI\$5,000.00
For processing of bech de mers, black lip and trochus	SI\$2,000.00
Farming licence for prawns, crocodile, clams and fish	SI\$2,500.00
Port entry fee	SI\$100.00
Transshipment fee (per vessel per year)	US\$600.00
Transshipment levy - (canning grade)	US\$2.00 per tone
(sashimi grade)	US\$12.00 per tone
Duplicate licence (all classes)	SI\$100.00."
