THE HONIARA CITY ACT 1999
(No. of 1999)**DETERMINATION OF THE HONIARA CITY COUNCIL MAYOR'S
ENTITLEMENTS**

IN exercise of the powers conferred by Section 15 of the Honiara City Act 1999, the Members of Parliament (Entitlements) Commission hereby determines the Mayor's entitlements to be as follows -

1. The Mayor shall be paid an annual gross salary of \$50,000.00, which is to be paid on a fortnightly basis. Salary
2. The Mayor whilst on official overseas trips shall be paid a daily subsistence allowance of US\$150.00 per day. While attending official business in the provinces, the Mayor shall be paid a daily subsistence of \$150.00. Subsistence Allowance
3. The Honiara City Council shall provide the Mayor with a suitable furnished accommodation. However, where the Mayor opts to remain in his private accommodation, the Honiara City Council shall pay him a housing allowance of \$5,000.00 per month. Accommodation
4. The Honiara City Council shall provide and pay for the salary of a domestic servant for the Mayor. Domestic servant
5. The cost of gas, water and electricity at the Mayor's residence shall be paid for by Honiara City Council. Utilities
6. The cost of installation and rental of telephone bills at the Mayor's residence shall be paid for by the Honiara City Council. The Honiara City Council shall also provide the Mayor with a mobile telephone but that all his personal calls be paid for by the Mayor to the City Council in full at the beginning of each month for the month before. - Driver 7. During all official events of the Honiara City Council, the Honiara City Council shall provide the Mayor with a Honiara City Council official vehicle and a driver to drive the Mayor to such events.
- Leave 8. The Mayor shall be entitled to three (3) weeks paid annual leave. This leave to commence on 5th September 2006.
