[Legal Notice No. 55]**LIQUOR ACT**  
**(Cap. 144)****THE BANNING OF THE SALE OF LIQUOR ORDER (NO.2) 2015**

**IN** exercise of the powers conferred under section 82(1) of the Liquor Act, the Minister hereby makes the following Order –

1. This Order may be cited as the Banning of Sale of Liquor Order (NO.2) 2015 and shall come into force upon publication in the *Gazette*.
2. No liquor shall be sold from any licensed retail premises including night clubs or Bottle Shops, from Lambi to Aola, Guadalcanal Province effective from mid night of 23<sup>rd</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> June 2015.
3. Any person who contravenes subsection (2) commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding 2,000 penalty units or to imprisonment not exceeding 6 months.
4. The banning on sale by retail or supply of liquor does not apply to sale or supply of liquor by a hotel to its bona fide guest accommodated at the Hotel or at restaurant.
