Short title

ment.

1. This Ordinance shall be entitled the "Western Province Appropriation Ordinance 1993" and shall come into force upon approval of the Minister in accordance with section 32 of the Provincial Government Act 1981 and publication in the Solomon Islands Gazette.

2. The appropriation from the Provincial Fund is hereby authorised of the sum of six million four hundred and twenty-nine thousand, and three dollars, to be applied for the purposes specified in section 36(2) of the Provincial Government Act, and to the services of the financial year ending 31st March 1994.

3. The sum specified in the preceeding section shall be appropriated for the supply of the heads (codes) specified, and in the amounts respectively, specified in the relation thereto in the schedule 1 to this Ordinance.

4. The Financial Statement 1993 Appropriation are contained at the Schedule 2 to this Ordinance.
