THE POLICE ACT 1972
(No. 6 of 1972)THE POLICE (SPECIAL DUTY ALLOWANCE) (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS 1997

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 72 of the Police Act, 1972, the Prime Minister hereby makes the following regulations -

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police (Special Duty Allowance) (Amendment) regulations 1997.

2. The Police Regulations* are hereby amended by deleting the First Schedule thereto, and substituting therefor the following new Schedule -
