**CONSTITUTION OF SOLOMON ISLANDS  
(SCHEDULE TO LN 43 OF 1978)****STANDING ORDERS OF THE NATIONAL PARLIAMENT OF  
SOLOMON ISLANDS AMENDMENT 2011**

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 62 of the Constitution, the National Parliament of Solomon Islands makes the following Order –

- Citation and commencement
1. This Order may be cited as the Standing Orders of the National Parliament of Solomon Islands Amendment 2011, and commences on the date of publication in the *Gazette*.
- New Standing orders added
2. The Standing Orders of the National Parliament of Solomon Islands is amended by inserting after standing order 71B the following new standing orders –

**‘EDUCATION AND HUMAN RESOURCES  
DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE**

71C. There shall be a Standing Select Committee designated the Education and Human Resources Development Committee whose functions shall be to examine and make its observations and recommendations on matters relating to education and human resources development referred to it by Parliament or the Government.

**HEALTH AND MEDICAL SERVICES COMMITTEE**

71D. There shall be a Standing Select Committee designated the Health and Medical Services Committee whose functions shall be to examine and make its observations and recommendations on matters relating to health and medical services referred to it by Parliament or the Government.

**POLICE AND NATIONAL SECURITY COMMITTEE**

71E. There shall be a Standing Select Committee designated the Police and National Security Committee whose functions shall be to examine and make its observations and recommendations on matters relating to police and national security, including correctional service referred to it by Parliament or the Government.”.

PASSED by resolution of Parliament on the twelfth day of April, 2011.
