LEROY WHARF PORT DECLARATION ORDER

I, Hon. Manasseh Maelanga, Minister for Infrastructure Development, under section 5 of the *Ports Act* (Cap. 161), make the following Order:

1. Citation

This Order may be cited as the *Leroy Wharf Declaration Order*.

2. Commencement

This Order commences on the date it is published in the *Gazette*.

3. Definition of “Leroy Wharf Port”

In this Order:

“*Leroy Wharf Port*” means the area in Solomon Islands that is, bounded by a line with coordinates specified in the Schedule.

4. Leroy Wharf Port declared port

Leroy Wharf Port, located at Lungga Point, Guadalcanal Province, to be a declared port.
