**CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (TERMS AND CONDITIONS

(Cap. 84)**

**CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE)
(CHIEF JUSTICE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2025**

I, Hon. Jeremiah Manele, Prime Minister, under section 3 of the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) Act* (Cap. 84), make the following Regulations:

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Chief Justice) (Amendment) Regulations 2025*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the date these Regulations are published in the *Gazette*.

**3 Amendment of Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service)
(Chief Justice) Regulations 2015**

These Regulations amend the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Chief Justice) Regulations 2015* (Legal Notice No. 72 of 2015) (“*Principal Regulations*”).

4 Regulation 7 amended

Regulation 7(2) of the *Principal Regulations* is amended by deleting

“4 years” and substituting “1 year”.

5 New regulation 28B inserted

The Principal Regulations is amended by inserting the following after regulation 28A:

“28B Retirement benefits

- (1) A retired Chief Justice is entitled to:
 - (a) a housing allowance equal to 60% of the housing allowance applicable at the time of retirement;
 - (b) a vehicle provided by the Government, and the Government is responsible for all costs of repair and maintenance, except for the cost of fuel.
- (2) The surviving spouse of a retired Chief Justice is entitled to a housing allowance equal to 20% of the housing allowance payable to the retired Chief Justice at the time of his or her death.
- (3) The housing allowance of the surviving spouse in subregulation (2) ends, if the surviving spouse remarries or dies.
- (4) The vehicle benefit of the retired Chief Justice in subregulation (1)(b) ends at the time of his or her death.”.

6 Regulation 31 amended

Regulation 31 of the Principal Regulations is amended by deleting “annually” and substituting “every 3 years”.

7 Schedule deleted and substituted

The Principal Regulations is amended by deleting the Schedule and substituting the following:

**CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE)
(DEPUTY CHIEF JUSTICE) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2025**

I, Hon. Jeremiah Manele, Prime Minister, under section 3 of the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) Act* (Cap. 84), make these Regulations:

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Deputy Chief Justice) (Amendment) Regulations 2025*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the date these Regulations are published in the *Gazette*.

3 Amendment of Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Deputy Chief Justice) Regulations 2015

These Regulations amend the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Deputy Chief Justice) Regulations 2015* (Legal Notice No. 73 of 2015) (“*Principal Regulations*”).

4 Regulation 7 amended

Regulation 7(2) of the Principal Regulations is amended by deleting “4 years” and substituting “1 year”.

5 New regulations 28A and 28B inserted

The Principal Regulations is amended by inserting the following after regulation 28:

“28A Pension scheme

- (1) A retired Deputy Chief Justice is entitled to an annual pension equal to 40% of the annual salary applicable at the time of retirement.
- (2) The surviving spouse of a retired Deputy Chief Justice is entitled to a pension equal to 20% of the pension payable to the retired Deputy Chief Justice at the time of his or her death.
- (3) The pension of the surviving spouse in subregulation (2) ends, if the surviving spouse remarries or dies.

28B Housing allowance for retired Deputy Chief Justice

- (1) A retired Deputy Chief Justice is entitled to a housing allowance equal to 60% of the housing allowance applicable at the time of retirement.
- (2) The surviving spouse of a retired Deputy Chief Justice is entitled to a housing allowance equal to 20% of the housing allowance payable to the retired Deputy Chief Justice at the time of his or her death.
- (3) The housing allowance of the surviving spouse in subregulation (2) ends, if the surviving spouse remarries or dies.”.

6 Regulation 31 amended

Regulation 31 of the Principal Regulations is amended by deleting “annually” and substituting “every 3 years”.

7 Schedule deleted and substituted

The Principal Regulations is amended by deleting the Schedule and substituting the following:

**CONSTITUTIONAL OFFICES (TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE)
(PUISNE JUDGES (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2025**

I, Hon. Jeremiah Manele, Prime Minister, under section 3 of the *Constitutional Offices*

(Terms and Conditions of Service) Act (Cap. 84), make these Regulations:

1 Citation

These Regulations may be cited as the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Puisne Judges) (Amendment) Regulations 2025*.

2 Commencement

These Regulations commence on the date these Regulations are published in the *Gazette*.

3 Amendment of Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Puisne Judges) Regulations 2015

These Regulations amend the *Constitutional Offices (Terms and Conditions of Service) (Puisne Judges) Regulations 2015* (Legal Notice No. 74 of 2015) (“*Principal Regulations*”).

4 Regulation 7 amended

Regulation 7(2) of the *Principal Regulations* is amended by deleting “4 years” and substituting “1 year”.

5 New regulations 28A and 28B inserted

The *Principal Regulations* is amended by inserting the following after regulation 28:

“28A Pension scheme

- (1) A retired Puisne Judge is entitled to an annual pension equal to 30% of the annual salary applicable at the time of retirement.
- (2) The surviving spouse of a retired Puisne Judge is entitled to a pension equal to 20% of the pension payable to the retired Puisne Judge at the time of his or her death.
- (3) The pension of the surviving spouse in subregulation (2) ends, if the surviving spouse remarries or dies.

28B Housing allowance for retired Puisne Judge

- (1) A retired Puisne Judge is entitled to a housing allowance equal to 60% of the housing allowance applicable at the time of retirement.
- (2) The surviving spouse of a retired Puisne Judge is entitled to a housing allowance equal to 20% of the housing allowance payable to the retired Puisne Judge at the time of his or her death.
- (3) The entitlement of the surviving spouse to receive the housing allowance under subregulation (2) ends, if the surviving spouse remarries or dies.”.

6 Regulation 31 amended

Regulation 31 of the Principal Regulations is amended by deleting “annually” and substituting “every 3 years”.

7 Schedule deleted and substituted

The Principal Regulations is amended by deleting the Schedule and substituting the following:
