CONSUMPTION TAX ACT [CAP 11.01]

(Section 5(3)(a))

ORDER

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 5(3)(a) of the Consumption Tax Act [CAP 11.01], the Minister responsible for revenue and customs, with the approval of Cabinet makes the following Order –

- (1) That all import of all building materials for the constructions of private dwellings, community project buildings and education project buildings shall be exempted from consumption tax;
- (2) That the application of paragraph (1) of this Order shall be subject to the endorsement of the Chief Executive Officer for the Ministry of Revenue and Customs;
- (3) That this Order shall come into force on the date of gazettal; and
- (4) That this Order shall expire on 31 March 2021.

ORDER

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3(1)(b) of the Customs Act [CAP 11.02], the Minister responsible for revenue and customs, with the approval of Cabinet makes the following Order -

- (1) That all import of building materials for the construction of private dwellings, community project buildings and education project buildings shall be exempted from customs duty;
- (2) That the application of paragraph (1) of this Order shall be subject to the endorsement of the Chief Executive Officer for the Ministry of Revenue and Customs;
- (3) That this Order shall come into force on the date of gazettal; and
- (4) That this Order shall expire on 31 March 2021.
