Defendant: Yes I have borrowed VT 59,000  
from the defendant Peter Bebe.

Plaintiff: Vincent borrowed VT 59,000 from me  
in December 1993. I took him  
to work for me. I went to Pentecost  
for my Sister's marriage. I told  
him to work for me in my place.  
I went to Pentecost when I  
return he had used up the  
money. I have a business  
maintaining things. At that time  
I was working on a house at Seaside area.  
Put Vincent on that



That he repaired the house. When he had completed the work he went to the public works dept. asked for an invoice and then ~~was~~ had a cheque paid to him for an amount of VT59,000

Defendant: I took the money because he didn't pay my salary for two weeks in December 1993 and January 1994. If he had paid my salary I would not take the money. For the repair work he only paid for paint.

Plaintiff: It is true that I didn't pay him salary. I had told him that he would pay me back VT42,000 only. The rest would be gone towards his salary.

Defendant: That was not enough. My price is VT250 per hour. I had work for two weeks in December he paid me VT6000 to me. I already paid him VT5,000.



Plaintiff: He had work only for a week or so. In December 1993 there was no work given to ~~me~~. I don't agree with VT250 per hour. He never told me when I asked him to work for me that he gets paid VT250 per hour.

Defendant: No I didn't tell him I work for VT250 per hour.

Plaintiff: I had told him to work for me. I felt sorry for him because he was overentraped I took him to work for me.

Defendant: I am willing to pay him back by instalments of VT5000 per month.

Cour order: That the defendant pay to the plaintiff the sum of VT4000 plus VT2000 costs by instalments of VT5000 per month commencing 20/3/95.
