EX PARTE INTERIM ORDER

UPON hearing the Applicant and UPON reading the Affidavit of the Applicant herein and UPON the usual undertaking as to damages by the Applicant, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:-

1. That the Respondent, his Agents and Nominees are until final determination by the Island Court of the Applicant's custom ownership dispute be restrained from:-
 - (a) assaulting, threatening or harassing the Applicant or his Agents or nominees;
 - (b) approaching contacting or communicating with the Applicant, his Agents or Nominees whether directly or indirectly.
 - (c) entering or going inside the project site as is sheded in the attached sketch map.
 - (d) entering any premises where the Applicant, his Agents or Nominees is living.
 - (e) damaging or destroying any property of the Applicant, his Agents or Nominees.

2. That if the Order is breached (broken) the Respondent, his Agents or Nominees will be arrested by the Police and brought before the court to be dealt with for the breach as a Contempt of Court.
3. These Orders will remain in force until the 28th February 1997 unless a cause of action is filed by the said date.
4. That the Commissioner of Police be advised of this order and a copy be served on him.
5. That either party has liberty to apply.
6. That the costs of the application be reserved.

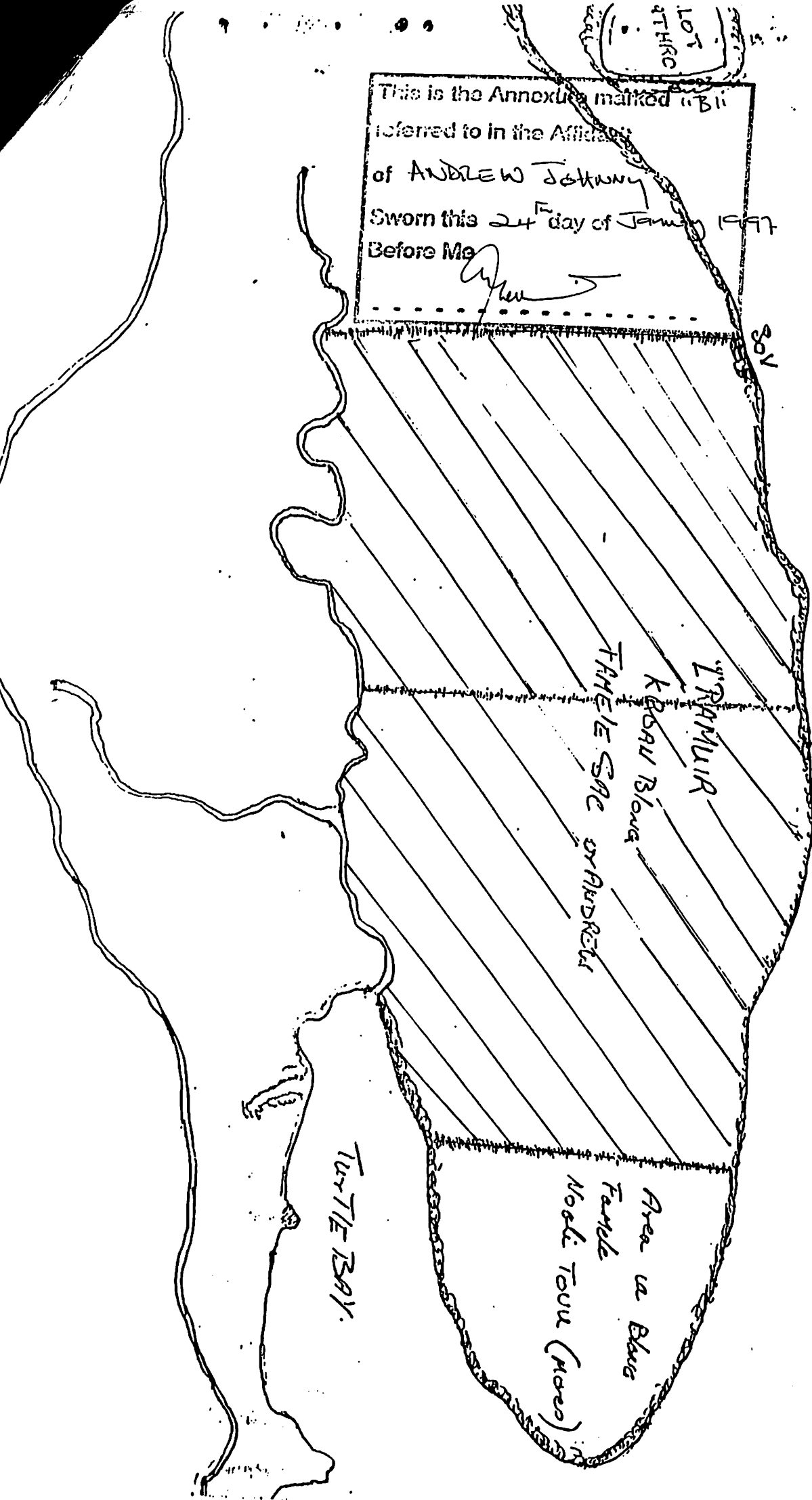
