i no kat eye witness long claim blong hem long  
ol kakai ia, olsem chiefs long village -

Plaintiff " Me been move three times blong mekem  
hemi save se ol bullucks i cut long fence  
mo kam kakai garden - From ol bulluck i  
continue blong kam, so me mekem action  
blong cuttem one long knife so i mekem se  
hemi kat will long eye blong hem."
