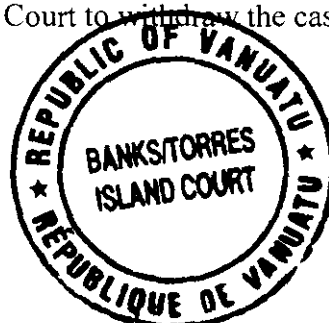

JUDGMENT

This is a claim for compensation filed before this Court by Charles Bice Wongrass. On his statement he claimed that the defendant's laborers have entered his land without permission and carry out quarrying of sand which causes damage to the land. He sought before this Court a relief of VT 50,000 compensation from the defendant.

The Court will determine issues raised by the complainant against the defendant. If the defendant are liable over the case then how much would they be oblige to pay to the complainant? This is the issue for determination before this Court.

Both parties are served with Court summons to appear before the Court. Before proceeding with case, the complainant submits a written application before the Court to withdraw the case filed against the defendant. His application reads:

With the complainant's application for withdrawal of the case, the Court hereby gives the following orders.


Court orders:


- 1. That this case is withdrawn and case file be closed.**
- 2. Any party who is dissatisfied with this order has liberty to appeal within 30 days as of today.**


