JUDGMENT

The defendant, **CLEMO ANPAU AND ALFRED JUNIOR**, are charged with the offence, both parties pleaded guilty to the charges of **IDLE & DISORDERLY**, against section 148 penal code act cap 135.

The facts provided by the prosecutor states that, on the 31st of December 2010 at Government Building, Clemo Anpau & Alfred Junior were drunk intoxicated alcohol liquor were found to be acting in a disorderly manner in a public place.

Having heard the evidence provided by both parties,
THE COURT HEREBY MAKES the following orders:

1. Defendant **Junior Alfred** to Pay Vt1500 court fines to the court and also pay Vt1000 cost to the Public Prosecutor. Payment is to be made within seven (7) days.
2. While Defendant **Clemo Anpau** be imprisoned for a period of seven (7) days

3. It is noted that upon making this order the defendant **Clemo Anpau** was in a custody sentence ordered by the Supreme Court. **Seven (7) days** of imprisonment be served thereafter.
