JUDGMENT

CLAIMANT- Appears before the court

DEFENDANT – Present before the court

The clerk presents the civil case and summarises through the claimants' application made before the court by the claimant claiming against the defendant the amount of VT 50,000 being for damages made to his property by the defendant. After the defendant was charged for trespass and damage to property in regards to Criminal case 59 of 2014 dated 18 day of June 2014 he was to pay fine to the Magistrates court and now the claimant is claiming for the damages made to his garden goods and also for his travelling arrangement s.



The defendant respond and stated in court and admits claim of damages made against him and that also he has already paid for his fines in regards to the Criminal case 59 of 2014.

Upon hearing the application the court hereby made the following:

FINDINGS

The defendant has been charged due to tress pass and damage to property of Criminal case 59 of 2014. The claimant has no prove in providing report from either a village chief or Agriculture assistant who assisted in observing the damages made by the defendant and also not every receipts were provided to confirm of travelling expenses being made.


COURT ORDER

1. The defendant to pay a total amount of VT 15,420 which VT 9,970 plane tickets, VT 3,450 Ship fare, tax fee, court fee and transport fares.
2. The total amount to be completed within 5 months beginning from the November 2014 of an amount if VT 3,000 and continuously till March 2015 last and complete payment of VT 3,420 to complete the total amount of VT 15,420.
3. If both parties are not happy with the Island court decision has within 30 days the right to appeal to the Magistrate Court which in accordance to the Island Courts ACT CAP 167 section 22.


