3. The cow was tied up closely to the defendants house
4. No one knows the cow was tied up at the defendants yard except for him and even though he saw the cow there he failed to seek within his family to find out who tied the cow there


**THE COURT HEREBY MAKES** the following Orders;


1. The defendant to pay an amount of VT 20,000 for the cow, VT 5,000 for the baby inside the cow and VT 1,000 for the court fee which totals up to an amount of VT26,000
2. The mentioned fines referring to order 1 to be made by first week of next month June 2014 and to be paid in installments of VT 65,00 every month to the office of the Island court until the total amount of VT 26,000 is completed by the first week of the month of September 2014
3. Both parties have the right to appeal if not happy with the Island court decision to the Magistrate courts within 30 days upon receiving the Judgment.
