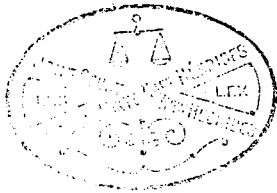


THE JOINT COURT OF THE ILES HEBRIDES.

This seventeenth day of October one thousand nine hundred and thirteen, in the matter of a charge against A. MacDonald:

The above named A. MacDonald stands convicted before the Joint Court for that on or about the 12th October he supplied alcoholic liquor to a native named Kalsal contrary to the provisions of Article LIX of the Convention;

THEREUPON the Joint Court sentences the said A. MacDonald for his said offence to pay a penalty of one pound (£1) and the costs of these proceedings.
