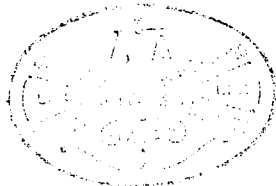


This twenty first day of November one thousand nine hundred and thirteen in the matter of a charge against A.R. Johns of Tongoa.

The above named A.R. Johns stands convicted in default of appearance before the Joint Court for that on or about Christmas 1912 at Tongoa New Hebrides he did sell alcoholic liquor to the natives Willie Talia, Willie Sorka, Willie Bongalong, Jack Vallia, Pakoa, David Limbacoot contrary to the provisions of Article LIX of the Convention.

Thereupon the Joint Court sentences the said A.R. Johns for his said offence to pay a penalty of two pounds (£2) and the costs of these proceedings.
