This twentysixth day of June 1923,

In the matter of a charge against MINTO MAC'COY, of EFATE.

The above named MINTO MAC'COY stands convicted before the Joint Court for that ~~XXXXX~~ on or about the 16th or 17th of December 1922 he supplied alcoholic liquor to the natives:
