

JOINT COURT OF THE NEW HEBRIDES

CONFIRMATION OF JUDGMENT

This first day of June one thousand nine hundred and thirty four.


Whereas a judgment was delivered by default by the Court of First Instance, Central District, No 2, on the 16th May 1933, sentencing UCHIDA KAMEGO, Japanese, French ressortissant to one month imprisonment and a fine of 500 francs for the sale of alcoholic liquor to a native.


