Greeting.

Whereas, by Instrument under the Public Seal dated the tenth day of November 1976, Louis Georges Souyave. Knight, was appointed a Judge of the High Court of the New Hebrides:

and whereas the said Louis Georges Souyave is unable to perform the functions of his Office in the cause or matter intituled Armco Pacific Financial Services Limited, Petitioner, v D. J. Gubbay and Company (New Hebrides) Proprietary Limited, Respondent, Civil Case 1962 of 1977, a Petition for the winding-up of the said D. J. Gubbay and Company (New Hebrides) Proprietary Limited: and whereas it is provided by Section 12C(!) of Schedule 1 to the New Hebrides Order 1973 that if a Judge is for any reason unable to perform the functions of his Office the High Commissioner may by Instrument under the Public Seal appoint a person qualified for appointment as a Judge of the High Court to act as a Judge: now therefore in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Section 12C(1) of Schedule 1 to the New Hebrides Order 1973 I hereby appoint you the said John Francis Willis Judge to act as a Judge of the High Court for the New Hebrides for the purpose of hearing and determining the herein before recited Petition and to have, perform and exercise in relation thereto all and singular duties of such Office together with the rights, powers, immunities and privileges incident thereto and thereunto appertaining.
