## JOINT REGULATION

No. 5 of  
1967.

To bring into effect the Estimates of the Joint Administration for the year 1967.

[Published: Condominium Gazette No. 253.]

MADE by the British and French Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 5, 7, paragraph 2 of Article 2 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914 and section 5 of the Joint Finance Regulation No. 10 of 1957, after consultation with the Advisory Council and with the approval of the Governments of Her Majesty and of the French Republic.

1. This Regulation may be cited as the 1967 Appropriation Joint Regulation.

2. The Estimates of the Joint Administration of the year 1967 shall provide for—

- (a) Revenue for the amount of Nine Hundred and Fifty Four Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty Three pounds sterling (£Stg. 954,863) or Two Hundred and Thirty Eight Million Seven Hundred and Fifteen Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty New Hebrides francs (238,715,750 francs N.H.);
- (b) Expenditure to the amount of Nine Hundred and Fifty Four Thousand Six Hundred and Thirteen pounds sterling (£Stg. 954,613) or Two Hundred and Thirty Eight Million Six Hundred and Fifty Three Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty New Hebrides francs (238,653,250 francs N.H.).

3. There shall be issued from General Revenue and other funds of the Joint Administration and applied to the service of the year ending 31st December, 1967 a sum not exceeding that specified in subsection (b) of section 2 of this Regulation. The said amount shall be appropriated as set out in the schedule to this Regulation.

4. The Resident Commissioners may jointly authorize the Ordonnateur and the Condominium Treasurer to control expenditure, each according to his responsibilities as set out in Joint Standing Order No. 4 of 1957 within the limits fixed by such authorization; such sums shall not exceed on the whole the sum specified in subsection (b) of Section 2 of this Regulation.
