JOINT REGULATION 3 of 1941

A JOINT REGULATION

No. 3 of 1941.

to provide penalties for trespass by cattle

[Published: Condominium Gazette No. 124.]

Issued by the Resident Commissioners in accordance with the provisions of article 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. Any person who is the owner or who is in charge of any cattle who shall cause or permit any such cattle to stray or trespass on any public highway or on any land the property of any other person, shall be guilty of an offence against this Regulation, and shall on conviction be liable to a fine not exceeding £20 or imprisonment for one month or to both such fine and imprisonment.

Straying of cattle.

2. Prosecutions for infractions of the provisions of this Regulation shall be made by a Commandant of Police or a District Agent on the complaint of the owner, lessee or person in charge of the property on which the cattle have strayed or trespassed.

Prosecutions.

3. For the purposes of this Regulation, "cattle" shall be held to mean any animal of equine, bovine, asinine, porcine, ovine, caprine or cervine breed and any cross thereof.

Definition.

4. This Regulation shall come into force on the day of the date hereof and may be cited for all purposes as "The New Hebrides Cattle Trespass Regulation No. 3 of 1941".
