JOINT REGULATION 5 of 1928

JOINT REGULATION

[No. 5 of
1928.]

provide for the institution of a Court of First Instance.

WHEREAS by Article 21, paragraph (b) 4 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914, it is provided that Courts of First Instance shall be established in the Administrative Districts provided for in Article 2, paragraph 3, of the said Protocol;

And whereas by Proclamation dated 7th January, 1925, Administrative Districts hereinbefore referred to were established.

1. The Resident Commissioners of His Britannic Majesty and the French Republic hereby order that a Court of First Instance shall be instituted within the limits of Central District No. 2 with headquarters at a place known as Bushman's Bay on the island of Malekula, and such Court shall make circuits of the district as and when necessary. The territorial jurisdiction of such Court shall comprise the whole of Central District No. 2 as defined by Proclamation dated 7th January, 1925.

2. This Regulation shall come into force seven days after the arrival in Vila of the *Condominium Gazette* in which the present Regulation shall have been published.
