JOINT REGULATION 4 of 1969

JOINT REGULATION

No. 4 of 1969.

To provide for the appointment of and to define the powers of Condominium Rates and Taxes Officers.

[Published: Condominium Gazette No. 275.]

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of paragraph 2 of Article 2 and Article 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. Condominium Rates and Taxes Officers (hereinafter referred to as "Taxes Officers") shall be appointed to the Condominium Treasury and Customs Department in the form prescribed in the Schedule I to this Regulation.

Appointment of a Rates and Taxes Officer.

2. Without prejudice to the powers already vested in any other persons where a Taxes Officer has reason to believe that any person should be in possession of a valid licence required to be possessed under the provisions of any law or is liable in any sum to the Joint Administration of the Condominium of the New Hebrides he may demand by notice in writing in the form prescribed in the Schedule 2 of this Regulation of the production to him by the said person within such period as shall be contained in the said notice of the said licence and evidence of the payment of the said sum, as the case may be.

Powers of the taxes officer.

3. Any person who fails to produce the licence or evidence of the payment of the sum demanded, as the case may be, within the period contained in the notice aforesaid shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction thereof shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £2.30 or its equivalent in francs at the current rate of exchange.

Penalties.

4. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Rates and Taxes Officers Regulation No. 4 of 1969 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
