JOINT REGULATION 7 of 1960

JOINT REGULATION

No. 7 of
1960.

To provide for the Suppression of Interference with Radio Reception.

[Published: Condominium Gazette No. 209.]

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under Article 7 and paragraph 2 of Article 2 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. No person shall install or use any appliance, apparatus, or vehicle which by its installation or use causes interference with radio reception or transmission.

2. (a) The Condominium Radio Engineer or such persons as the Resident Commissioners may jointly appoint may at all times during the day and in the presence of the owner or his representative enter upon any premises and there inspect and test any such appliance, apparatus or at any place inspect or test any such vehicle.

(b) If any person refuses entry to his premises or permission to inspect or test any appliance, apparatus or vehicle as provided in paragraph (a) hereof the Court having criminal jurisdiction over the person may by order authorise such entry inspection or test.

3. Where any appliance, apparatus or vehicle is found to be or be capable of causing interference with radio reception or transmission the Resident Commissioners may by notice in writing require the owner or user to deal therewith in such manner as adequately to suppress such interference and stipulate the time within which it shall be done.

4. Any person who shall install or use any appliance, apparatus or vehicle contrary to Section 1 hereof, or who shall fail to comply with any order issued under Section 2 (b), or who shall fail or refuse to comply with any notification given in accordance with the next following section shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction shall be liable to a penalty not exceeding £20 or its equivalent in francs at the current rate of exchange, or one month's imprisonment or both such penalties.

Section 4 of the Vila Town Electricity Supply Joint Regulation No. 23 of 1941 is hereby repealed.

6. This Joint Regulation may be cited as the Suppression of Interference with Radio Reception Joint Regulation No. 7 of 1960.
