JOINT REGULATION 4 of 1965

JOINT REGULATION

No. 4 of
1965.

To prohibit the alienation of land on the Island of Tongoa.

MADE by the British and French Resident Commissioners under the provisions of paragraph 2 (G) of Article 27 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

1. Joint Regulation No. 3 of 1939, No. 1 of 1962 and No. 21 of 1964 are hereby repealed.

2. Subject to the provisions of the next succeeding Section of this Regulation from and after the date hereof, no sale or grant of land at present in native ownership and situated on the Island of Tongoa and no sale or grant of any interest in any such land shall be made to any non-native.

3. (1) The provisions of the preceding section of this Regulation shall not apply—

(a) To the grant of land or any interest therein to be used for educational, medical or religious purposes, or for the housing of the staff connected therewith.

Provided that any such land shall be used only for the purpose for which it is granted and shall revert to the owner should it cease to be so used.

(b) To the grant of a lease of land to the Resident Commissioners; and,

(c) To the grant of land or interest therein to the Tongoa Local Council.

(2) Where any land or interest therein has been granted under the provisions of paragraph (a) of the preceding subsection of this section a copy of the agreement under which such grant is made shall be sent to each Resident Commissioner through the District Agents within one month of signature by the parties thereto.

4. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Tongoa Lands Sales (Prohibition) Regulation No. 4 of 1965, and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
