JOINT REGULATION

No. 31 of 1974

TO AMEND the Joint Control of Traffic Regulation No. 4 of 1962 as amended.

MADE by the Resident Commissioners under the provisions of Articles 2:2 and 7 of the Anglo-French Protocol of 1914.

Replacement of s.45 of J.R. No. 4 of 1962

1. Section 45 of the Joint Control of Traffic Regulation No. 4 of 1962 as from time to time amended is hereby repealed and replaced by the following section -

"45. Save as provided in sections 18, 46 and 47, every person convicted of an offence against this Regulation shall be liable to a fine not exceeding 5000 FNH or the equivalent thereof in Australian dollars or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding one month or to both such fine and imprisonment:

Provided that in the case of any person alleged to have committed an offence against this Regulation punishable under this section or section 18 who has not been convicted of any offence against this Regulation within the preceding period of three years, the appropriate police officer may in his discretion upon consideration of the facts of the alleged offence issue to such person a compounding notice giving him the option of paying a fixed fine equivalent to one half of the maximum fine which may be imposed by a court or of appearing before the court for trial. ".

Citation and commencement

2. This Regulation shall be cited as the Joint Control of Traffic (Amendment) Regulation No. 31 of 1974 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
