THE CITIZENSHIP (ENTITLED PERSONS)

REGULATION

Explanatory Note

The purpose of this Regulation is to provide for the manner in which persons entitled to citizenship under Article 10 of the Constitution may apply.

In Section 3 provision is made for the Minister to extend the time for application if he is satisfied that an applicant has sufficient excuse for not making an earlier application.

Section 5 provides for publication of names of persons registered as citizens.

Under Section 8 the Minister may retain a citizenship certificate until he is satisfied that a person has renounced his other citizenship but the Minister may extend the time limit for renounciation.

Section 9 provides heavy penalties for giving false information.

DRAFT RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION NO OF 1980

To provide for applications for Citizenship by entitled person.

The Representative Assembly of the New Hebrides at its sitting on the 1980 hereby resolves and decides in accordance with Article 23 of the Schedule to the Exchange of Notes of the 15th Soptember 1977 to adopt the following measures :-

Interpretation. 1.

In this Regulation unless the context atherwise provides —
"Entitled person" means a person to whom Article 10 of the
Constitution applies.
"Minor" means a person who has not attained the age of 18
years;
"Minister" means the Minister for the time being responsible for citizonship — a Minister acting on his behalf or

Application by entitled person.

2. (1) Subject to subsection (2) an entitled person who desires to apply for citizenship of the Republic of Vanuatu shall make application by completing an application in form "A" in the Schedule to this Regulation and lodging it with the Minister.

(2) The parent or lawful guardian of a minor who is an entitled person shall make application on behalf of that minor desires to be a citizen.

- 3. (1) Subject to subsections (2) and (3) an application under section 2 shall be lodged in the time provided for in Article 10 of the Constitution.
 - (2) The Minister may retrospectively or otherwise extend the time limit in Article 10 of the Constitution for making application for citizenship by not more than 6 months if he is satisfied that the applicant has sufficient excuse for not making an earlier application.
 - (3) A minor who is an untitled person may make an application provided for in Section 2 (1) within 3 menths after his eighteenth birthday.

4. If the Ministor is satisfied that a person who applies for citizenship in accordance with section 2 is an entitled person he shall subject to section 8 register him as a citizen and issue him with a cortificate in Form 8 in the Schedule and the person named therein shall be a citizen from the date in the cortificate.

ublication of ames of ogistored itizons.

5. The Minister shall publish the names of persons registered in accordance with this Regulation in the Vanuatu Gazette not later than 30 days after registration.

- 6. The Minister shall keep a register of persons registered as citizens in accordance with this Regulation.
- osa of itizonahip.
- . A person registered in accordance with this Regulation shall only coase to be a citizen if :-
 - (a) the Supreme Court declares that when registered he was not an entitled person;
 - (b) ho fails to renounce any other citizenship or nationality within three menths of registration or such further period as the Minister may allow under section 8 (2);
 - (c) he fails to renounce any other citizenship in accordance with Article 13 of the Constitution or
 - (d) he renounces his citizenship of Vanuatu.

ertificates and xtension of ime for sounciation.

- 8. (1) The Minister may retain a certificate issued in accordance with section 4 until he is satisfied that the person named therein has renounced any other citizenship or nationality he may have at the time of registration.
 - (2) The Minister may extend the time limit in Article 10 of the Constitution for renunciation of other citizenship or nationality by not more than 3 months if a person applies to him for such extension within 3 months of being issued with a certificate in accordance with Section 4.

enalties.

9. Any person who for the purpose of being registered or obtaining the registration of any other person as a citizen under this regulation knowingly gives any false information to any person commits an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding 75,000 FNH or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding 5 years or to both.
