1. From the time twelve o'clock midday, Greenwich Mean Time, on the 30th day of March 1974, the time for general purposes of the New Hebrides shall revert to eleven hours in advance of Greenwich Mean Time.

2. The Joint Daylight Saving Regulation No.59 of 1973 is hereby repealed.

3. This Regulation may be cited as the Joint Daylight Saving (Repeal) Regulation No. 10 of 1974 and shall come into operation on the date of its publication in the Condominium Gazette.
